



# Tiger ROP Information

## Friday April 8, 2016

### General Information

Tiger ROP will be held at Reedley College. During the Tiger ROP student challenge, Reedley College will also hold a special "Open House" called **Safari Days**, which includes craft fair, food vendors, commercial and non-profit informational displays, and family friendly and musical entertainment. The event (except for the comedy show on Friday night) is open and free to the public.

### Competition Rules

Contests are open to high school students from Dinuba, Kingsburg, Orange Cove, Orosi, Parlier, Reedley, Sanger and Selma High School, 16 years of age and older. Each student may compete in **ONLY ONE COMPETITION**.

The Tiger ROP Committee has the right to limit the entries based on facilities available. Entries will be limited to five participants per school per event unless stated otherwise in the contest description.

An event may be canceled if there are **FEWER THAN FIVE STUDENTS COMPETING**, if the competition lacks a chairperson, or for other unexpected circumstances. The Tiger ROP Committee will notify participants if an event is canceled or changed.

Students and teachers will have to sign in the day of the competition at the location where the event is going to take place. All sponsoring teachers will receive a confirmed list of students entered in events and any special instructions from the Tiger ROP Committee prior to the competition. **STUDENTS NOT REGISTERED WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO PARTICIPATE!**

Roll call will be taken at each competition to insure student participation. All students must remain on the Reedley College campus for the duration of the Tiger ROP Competition. It will be the responsibility of the individual schools to monitor their students.

Reasonable precautions will be taken to protect materials and equipment brought by the competitor; however, the Tiger ROP Committee **WILL NOT** be responsible for loss or damage. All items brought to the contest by the competitors should be clearly marked with the participant's name, address and/or school.

The presentation of award and certificates will be held the same day of the competition after the events are completed. **NO INDICATIONS OF PLACEMENT IN THE CONTESTS WILL BE PROVIDED BEFORE THE AWARDS CEREMONY.**

Food is not provided to the students by the event organizers. Reedley College will have food available for purchase at designated booths.
